Electronic Single Window System Project, Republic of Kenya

SCE signed a contract in September 2012 with the Kenya Trade Network Agency (KENTRADE), an agency under the Kenyan Ministry of Finance, to design and implement the Kenyan Electronic Single Window System (KESWS).

For this project, SCE partnered with CrimsonLogic, a leading provider of eGovernment solutions and services in Singapore, to implement a new Trade Facilitation Solution in Kenya. The main feature of the KESWS is to enhance efficiency of cross-border trade at Kenyan seaports, airports and border posts.

It is envisaged that fully deployed; the system will enable traders to electronically submit documents to the relevant agencies to facilitate faster and more transparent cargo clearance. Agencies in Kenya can also share and exchange these related documentation electronically.

Beside cargo clearance, the new KESWS system will also help to streamline trade permit and license applications, increase administrative efficiency and provide significant cost savings to the Kenya trading community.

The project is concurrently ongoing.
