

## **Advisory / Project Implementation**

### **National Identity Card Project, Republic of Mauritius**

In December 2009, SCE received a request from the Mauritius Government to provide advisory services for the implementation of their National Identity Card based on Singapore's experience in implementing our own National Identity Card.

An advisory contract was formalised and executed in 2010. In 2011, the recommendations were presented to the Steering Committee from the Mauritius Government. The advisory report was endorsed by the Mauritius Government and they subsequently requested for SCE to prepare and submit a proposal for the actual implementation of the Identity Card in Mauritius.

SCE aggregated the Singapore partners from CrimsonLogic, a leading provider of eGovernment solutions and services in Singapore; and NEC (Asia Pacific), to understand the requirements from the Mauritius Government and tailor-made a proposal for the implementation of the Identity Card.

A contract for the actual implementation work was inked in October 2012 by Mr. Kong Wy Mun, Chief Executive Officer of SCE and Mrs. Fong Weng, Senior Chief Executive from the Prime Minister's Office.

There are 2 phases to the implementation of this project and the project is envisaged to be completed by December 2014.

The Singapore team worked closely with the Mauritius Government and the first Mauritius Identity Card was officially launched on 17 September 2013. SCE's Chief Executive Officer and Singapore High Commissioner to Mauritius attended the ceremony on the invite by the Mauritius PM.

The project is current still underway to complete the conversion of the identity cards for the entire population of Mauritius.
