Study Visit from Thailand Government Officials

SCE was approached by the Bangkok Training International (BTR) to organize a study visit programme for officials from the Government of Thailand. The officials were interested to understand Singapore's experiences on topics like:

- Singapore's Economic Development and Transition; and Free Trade Agreements;
- Singapore Urban Planning;
- The changing role of Singapore's Government;
- Singapore's Land Transport Development; and
- Singapore's Development of New Town and Public Housing Policy, Community Development.

Based on this request, SCE put together a customized 2-day study visit programme which was conducted from 27 to 28 May 2014. There were a total of 33 Government officials that participated in this study visit. The officials were mainly from the Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives, Ministry of Public Health, Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment, Ministry of Labour, Ministry of Interior, Ministry of Education, Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment, Ministry of Justice; and Office of the Prime Minister.

During the study visit, SCE aggregated a team of consultants with the relevant expertise to share on the topics of interest from the delegation. The study visit included interactive policy dialogue sessions between the participants and the Singapore's experts.

SCE also arranged site visits for the delegations to the Urban Redevelopment Authority (URA) City Gallery, Marina Bay Financial Centre, Central Business District and Housing Development Board (HDB) Gallery to better provide the delegates with a real-life wholistic experience in Singapore.
