Building Sewage Waste Water Planning and Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) Capabilities for the Delhi Jal Board, India

In 2012, SCE received a request from Delhi Jal Board (DJB), India, to tap on Singapore's experience and success story on our NEWater Programme. DJB was keen to build capabilities for key officials to improve and efficiently operate sewage waste water collection and treatment facilities for the city of New Delhi; and also to acquire the necessary knowledge on Public-Private Partnership (PPP) project implementation.

DJB, established under the Delhi Jal Board Act, 1998, is responsible for the production and distribution of drinking water, as well as the collection, treatment and disposal of waste water and sewage for the city of New Delhi, India. The programme was endorsed by Mr. P. K. Tripathi, Chief Secretary, Government of NCT of Delhi.

A Grant Agreement was signed in June 2012 between SCE and DJB. The programme was co-funded by Temasek Foundation, Singapore, an organisation set up to support capacity and capability building programmes in Asia, for the grant amount of SGD \$463,149. It was co-funded by DJB for the amount of SGD \$202,710.

For this programme, SCE aggregated relevant expertise from Public Utilities Board (PUB), a Singapore's wastewater agency; and CH2M Hill, a company that has global presence in areas of consultancy and project management, to share PPP water experience.

Under this 12 month long programme, the Singapore experts conducted a series of workshops and advisory sessions on the adaptation of key best practices to improve and operate the sewage waste collection facilities in New Delhi.

The programme was successfully completed in December 2013 and trained more than 90 officials from DJB and other relevant agencies.

A pilot project has also been identified by DJB after the training and our Singapore experts are currently assisting DJB on the preparation of a PPP framework and tender documentation for the Coronation Pillar Water Reuse Project.
