

## **Training Programmes**

### **Building Transportation Planning and Management Capabilities for the City of Danang, Vietnam**

In 2010, through the World Bank – Singapore Urban Hub initiative, SCE received a request from the Danang People’s Committee to share Singapore’s experience in the development of an urban transportation plan; and also to provide capacity building in urban transportation and management capabilities for the Government official in the City of Danang, Vietnam.

The Danang People’s Committee is autonomously responsible for the city’s economic growth and urban plans. To address Danang’s future developmental needs, the city government had rolled out Danang’s city master plan of development to 2025. In order to help achieve a more economically and environmentally sustainable future as envisioned in the new master plan, Danang People’s Committee requested the World Bank and Singapore to help develop a new urban transport planning in the city that can be integrated with the latest city master plan.

A Grant Agreement was signed in 2010 between SCE and Danang People’s Committee to provide a customised advisory and capacity building programme to share Singapore’s urban transport policy experience and best practices. The programme was supported by Temasek Foundation, Singapore, an organisation set up to support capacity and capability building programmes in Asia, for the grant amount of SGD \$915,185. It was co-funded by Danang for the amount of SGD \$239,080.

SCE pooled together expertise from various Singapore Government agencies and privatised Government departments to deliver the programme.

The programme was successfully completed in 2012 and trained more than 210 Danang Government officials.
